The Chicago Chapter National Black MBA Association, Inc. High School Scholarship Details

The Chicago Chapter National Black MBA Association, Inc. Scholarship consists of at least two \$750.00 non-renewable scholarship awards that will be provided to high school graduating seniors with high academic achievement and proven leadership qualities. Scholarship recipients should have a strong desire to succeed, as well as meet all of the requirements outlined below. A complete application packet must be submitted for consideration.

Scholarship Requirements

To be eligible for the Chicago Chapter National Black MBA Association, Inc scholarship, each applicant must meet the following requirements:

- ❖ Demonstrate academic achievement by having a minimum 3.0 GPA (on a 4.0 scale) upon high school graduation **or** be currently participating in Chicago Chapter National Black MBA Association, Inc. Leaders of Tomorrow (LOT) Program
- ❖ Possess leadership qualities
- ❖ Must be currently enrolled and attending as a full time high school senior in Illinois or Northwest Indiana with an expected graduation date no later than June 30, 2018.
- ❖ Must be expected to be enrolled in an accredited four-year college or university for the fall 2018-2019 academic year.

Application Process Timeline

Accepting Applications (November 1, 2017 – December 1, 2017)

Reviewing Applications (December 1, 2017 – December 17, 2017)

Notification of Awards (December 18, 2017 – December 20, 2017)

Selection Criteria

Final selections will be based on the candidate's essay, academic achievements, community and extracurricular activities. A total minimum score of 85 points on a 100-point scale is required.

Award Disbursements

Scholarship winners will receive a one-year membership to the NBMBA (membership fees are deducted from the scholarship award), unless winner is a current member of the NBMBA. The scholarship award will be paid upon verification of enrollment.



Chicago Chapter National Black MBA Association, Inc. Scholarship Application Packet Guidelines

Each application packet must include the following information:

- 1. Completed Application Form**
 - a. The completed essay application, with all sections completed. Application must be typed.
- 2. Transcript**
 - a. Submit an official transcript from your high school with cumulative GPA listed (transcript must be unopened)
- 3. Acceptance Letter**
 - a. Submit a copy of the official acceptance letter received from university for enrollment 2018-2019.
- 4. Photograph**
 - a. Submit a recent headshot photograph for publicity purposes (preferably a 5X7 black and white or digital picture) **NO SNAPSHOTS**
- 5. Ethics Affidavit**
 - a. Ethics Affidavit disclosing personal and familial relationships and verification of submission.

Post Application Submissions

To receive the full disbursement of the scholarship award, you will be requested to submit the following information no later than **December 31, 2017**.

- 1. Enrollment Verification:** Submit official acceptance letter for 2018-2019 academic year.
- 2. Mailing Address:** Submit mailing address for distribution of scholarship award

NOTE: APPLICATIONS WITHOUT AFFIDAVIT, PHOTO, ESSAY, OR TRANSCRIPTS WILL BE CONSIDERED INCOMPLETE AND WILL DISQUALIFY YOUR ENTRY. ALL CORRESPONDENCE MUST BE SENT TO THE CHAPTER POST OFFICE BOX OR EDUCATION@CCNBMBAA.ORG FOR CONSIDERATION.
